



## **Chaparral High School Electronic Device Policy**

In compliance with school rules and Clark County School District regulations, electronic devices are not to be brought or utilized except on certain occasions during the instructional day; before school, during passing period, at lunch, and after school. Unfortunately, many students bring these items and at times these items are lost, misplaced, or stolen by other students.

Understand that if a locker is shared by more than one student, it is the responsibility of all involved to ensure the security of the locker. A lock must be utilized to ensure security and limited access to the locker. The gym/locker room area is an area that has multiple entrances and exits and is used throughout the day multiple times.

Students should not bring these items with them and if they must have them on their person or in their possession, they assume liability for these items. This includes taking items out to charge and leaving unsecured while charging, allowing others to borrow them during the day, and any other instances that may result in loss. These are highly lost/stolen items that are hard to retrieve. Their safety and security is the responsibility of the owner.
