- No more than 1 RPC **(If more than 1 RPC, request a printout of discipline record. Then, obtain approval from the AP over Activities and the Principal)**
- No current grade below a D
- Hold and maintain a 2.5 GPA
- No more than 10 unverified / unexcused absences for the current semester
- Parent Signature
- Teacher Recommendation
- Attend required information meeting: **Monday 10/16 @ 2:10 OR Tuesday 10/17 @ 2:10 ROOM 309**
- Application Approval before allowed to campaign

**Campaigning:**

- Campaigning begins **Wednesday, October 18, 2017** and ends **Friday, October 20, 2017**.
- Review the rules / expectations for campaigning
  - **Absolutely NO put downs** or negative comments about any other candidates. This includes speaking, writing or use of social media. You may only positively promote yourself.
  - **Absolutely NO** use of bribes to gain support. This includes but is not limited to promising favors, giving money, or giving candy in exchange for vote support.
  - **Absolutely NO** campaigning within the classroom. Other outside of the classroom.
  - Allowed 12 poster
  - Allowed 12 flyers (8.5X11 max size)
  - Campaigning material must be taken down by **Friday, October 20, 2017**.
  - All materials for campaigning are your responsibility to obtain / purchase. No student council material may be used except for the use of blue tape.
  - Failure to follow these rules will result in disqualification
