Title IX Recommendations

2016-2017

As part of the ongoing commitment to ensure the District's athletic and activities programs comply with Title IX of the Education Amendment of 1972, the following guidelines are recommended for 2016-2017 school year.

The District athletic department will do the following:

- Continue to conduct annual site visits and provide directions to schools on the Title IX Site Visit follow-up reports.
- Ensure all facility additions meet Title IX guidelines and are approved by the District's facility department and the Title IX office.
- Continue to work closely with the facilities department to provide a concession/press box facility at all high schools.
- Continue to promote and comply with the guidelines of the district-wide Girls' Intramural Program.
- Work closely with schools to utilize their intramural funds appropriately to promote archery in their Girls' Intramural Program.

All high schools will do the following:

- Post the name of the schools Title IX Coordinator on the school website.
- Post the list of sports offered by CCSD on the schools website for the entire school year.
- Continue to comply with CCSD Regulation 3241 and ensure that booster clubs funds and donations don't create an imbalance between the boys' and girls' athletic programs.
- Ensure all practice and competitive facilities (concession areas, restrooms, stands, etc.) for boys' and girls' teams are of equivalent quality.
- Continue to ensure all facility additions meet Title IX guidelines and are approved by the District's facility department and the Title IX office.
- Ensure that clubhouses and locker room facilities on or near the baseball field(s) are utilized in another capacity.
- Ensure the use of lights is equivalent for both boys' baseball and girls' softball programs.
- Continue to promote girls' flag football by:
 - Purchasing additional flag football uniforms and increasing rosters
 - Consider allowing flag football players to play offense or defense.
- Maintain and promote a Girls' Intramural Program.
- Continue to promote a girls' archery program.
 - Utilize portions of the school's intramural funds to purchase additional archery equipment.
 - Consider implementing an archery unit (six week) in their physical education program.
